Professor Mark Dyer (BEng BSc MA DPhil FICE FTCD CEng) is the Dean of the School of Engineering at the University of Waikato. Mark spent the first nineteen years of his professional career (with the exception of his PhD studies) working on construction projects in Europe, USA, Asia and Africa. The projects ranged from tunneling, deep foundation (Cementation Piling and Studio Geotecnico Italiano), flood defence (Humber Estuary), bioremediation of contaminated land (Rotterdam Botlek, Philips Zwolle, Tilburg, Napoli Siemens) and highways, waste management facilities comprising landfills, tailing dams, sewage treatment facilities (Acer Consulting, MRM Partnership).

Prior to his appointment as Dean of Engineering, he was appointed to chair professorships at Strathclyde University in Glasgow and Trinity College Dublin.



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
